

Conyers advises MBK Partners HK Limited in connection with the privatisation of eHi Car Services Limited by way of merger

The consideration to be paid to holders of common shares and ADSs implies an equity value for eHi of about US\$937.5 million.

The Company is a leading car rental and car services provider in China. It is the exclusive strategic partner in China to the brands Enterprise Rent-A-Car, National Car Rental and Alamo Rent A Car owned by Enterprise Holdings, Inc., the largest car rental provider in the world.
